Terms of Contract

Quotations are valid for 6 months

The first quote is free, however any re-quotes for the same work will be subject to a £20.0 + vat fee.

Quotes do not include for structural repairs that may be required

A Fensa registered company must fit all windows or the customer is required to apply for building regulations through their local council. The is the law

Invoices are issued in stage payments (every 2 weeks from start of manufacture) and to be paid within 7 days of issue. This includes labour charges and materials sed within the 2 week period. Any invoice outstanding beyond 7 days of due date will be referred to Daniels Silverman Limited and will be subject to a surcharge of 15% plus VAT to cover the collection cost is incurred. This surcharge with other charges and legal fees will be the responsibility of the customer, and will be legally enforceable.

Customer is responsible for clearing area where work is to be carried out. Please make sure all furniture is covered over and valuable ornaments etc are removed. Although great care is taken JFA Joinery cannot be held responsible for damage to items that have not been removed.

This quote is for mentioned work not clearing of cupboards or rooms where work is to be done. If we have to carry out any clearing of objects then a further charge will be added to the final bill.

Any extra work carried out, that is not included in the quotation, will be charged at a hourly rate + any extra materials used, and will be completed at a future date.

If an item is purpose made and the contract is signed and returned the customer will have 7 working days in which to cancel or make changes to the contract.

The 7 working days is taken from when the signed copy o the contract is received by JFA Joinery.

If no changes to purpose made item are received during this period, work will commence and any changes will be subject to an extra charge.

If on completion the customer decides not to keep the purpose made item and has not cancelled or changed the contract within the given time, then they must pay the agreed amount in full.

Please sign copy and return if quotation is accepted. Work will not commence until the copy is signed and returned.

If the customer suggests a time of fitting then it is rescheduled by the customer, a rescheduling charge will be added to the invoice of 10%.

Due to timber being a natural product, we cannot accept responsibility for shrinkage and expanding of the timber due to excessive heat and moisture conditions.

All external timber will be supplied white primed or base coat stained. The customer will be responsible for further coats of paint unless specified on the quotation.

All external timber must have a further 3 coats of paint on, Dulux weather shield (2 undercoat + 1 gloss) to retain the guarantee and must be recoated at maximum of every 5 years.

All internal timber and manmade sheet (eg ply and mdf) will be supplied unpainted unless specified within the quotation.
